TO PARENT: The purpose of this program is to provide students the opportunity to learn about entrepreneurship. The camp includes classroom instruction, guest speakers, and tours of local businesses. The camp will be held daily from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. from July 26-30, 2010. Transportation to and from the camp is the responsibility of the parents.

There is a fee of \$175 per student for the weeklong camp (early drop off and late pick up are available for an additional fee of \$10 per day). The \$175 fee helps cover costs that include instruction, class materials, camp t-shirt, bus transportation for tours, snacks, lunches and the graduation reception. A limited number of scholarships are available for those in need; please contact the Jacobson Institute for details.
